Very nice penthouse in a luxury apartment complex. The property consists of a cosy living/dining room with access to a huge covered terrace, which can be completely closed with glass. There are 2 double bedrooms, one of which has an en suite bathroom. There is also a guest bathroom, where the hot water boiler hangs and the washing machine is located. If you go to the solarium via a fixed interior staircase, you come to a very spacious terrace with a shower, for any cooling on a hot day. The penthouse was built only in 2018 and is as good as new. With the spacious arrangement of the apartment buildings in the complex and the well-maintained gardens, it immediately gives a sense of holiday. There are 3 swimming pools in the complex (an indoor pool, an outdoor play pool and an outdoor pool for swimming laps). There is also a sauna, fitness room, playground and table tennis area. Villamartin is the name of an urbanization and a golf course in Orihuela Costa which belongs to the province of Alicante and the Valencian Community on the Costa Blanca. It is considered to be one of the many new developments in this area of the Costa Blanca in recent times. Very popular with tourists, the majority of the population consists of expatriate communities from Europe that have settled there over the past 10 years, virtually transforming the initial small community into a modern looking town. The Villamartin urbanization is also known for its central plaza located near the Villamartin Golf Course. In this plaza you will find banks, supermarkets, a doctor's office and a wide range of bars, night clubs, cafes and restaurants, as well as several apartments. The square is built around a land populated with palm trees that are home to many families of ringed parrots from Africa. These parrots have achieved celebrity status, as many visitors are not used to seeing them in their home countries and have become another attraction in the area. Villamartin has two first class golf courses; Campo de Golf Villamartin, which hosted the 1994 Mediterranean Open, and Campo de Golf Las Ramblas. There are also numerous beaches, the closest being La Zenia beach. The geography is moderately undulating, with low hills and gentle slopes throughout the area, although it is somewhat warmer than the coastal areas, due to its inland location, it is less prone to the effects of strong winds from the sea. Villamartin also has other commercial areas, many of the services are located in the center of the main street of Villamartin, in general, all individual communities or urbanizations in the area have small commercial areas like "La Fuente" or "Los Dolses", where you can also find many shops, bars and restaurants. By now it is well known that Villamartin is a real paradise for golf lovers, thanks among others to the golf course from which the urbanization takes its name, and also the most modern one in the area known as "Las Ramblas". Villamartin Golf Course offers a round course of 6,277 m and par 72 and offers players a game of the highest quality naturally enhanced by the lush vegetation and surrounding wildlife. The Las Ramblas Golf Club, on the other hand, offers a 5,914 m golf course with 18 holes, which also enjoys an incomparable natural setting. Both golf courses also enjoy incredible views of the Mediterranean Sea. Although it may seem that the main attraction for tourism in the case of Villamartin revolves around everything related to the world of golf, the truth is that the possibilities are much more open, since its location allows you to visit in a short period of time, (5 or 10 minutes by car), the beautiful beaches that belong to the neighboring towns, most of these beaches are able to offer users a good provision of safety and facilities for the whole family and are qualified with the blue flag for its cleanliness and quality of its waters.
